# May I Quote You?

**Directions:** There is a formula for reporting a quotation in a newspaper article. It should include three parts.

- ✓ The exact words of the speaker in quotation marks.
- ✓ The first and last name of the speaker. (After the whole name is mentioned, additional quotations use only the last name.)
- ✓ A phrase to identify the position of the speaker.
